Election of Mayor

Deputy Mayor Rose wanted 2 thing clarified,

- 1. if the Council is "in" by acclamation is the Mayor chosen by the Council, Mayor stated that if the current Council is acclamated in the Council will be the same as the prior year (as they are now).
- 2. if there are more than 7 nominations and there is an election the nominee with the most votes from residents is offered Mayor, Mayor stated that that is correct.

Winter Letter

Mayor addressed Council did you councilors approve monies to pay me to fight against Salmon Cove excavating, Deputy Mayor Rose asked are you talking about "me" as in Mayor Arthur Petten or "me" as in Arthur Petten, Deputy Mayor Rose said he approved for Mayor Petten to go the appeal and represent the Town at the Appeal hearing ... a heated discussion ensued Councilor Percy left his seat at table and sat in delegate chair at 10:10 p.m. then he walked out of chambers at 10:14 p.m. Mayor called order to meeting Percy returned at 10:22 p.m.
