RECYCLING GUIDELINES

The Town of South River collects curb side recycling once every two weeks on Mondays, the same day as your garbage collection.

Please Note: Recycling is to be placed at the curb no later than 8 a.m. on collection day.

Please ensure the recycling is clean and sorted properly and does not contain any waste/garbage material

Materials Accepted

Containers

- Aluminum (e.g. pop and beer cans)
- Plastic Bottles (e.g. water, pop, liquor)
- Tetra Paks (e.g. juice boxes)
- Aluminum pie plates
- Milk containers
- Steet/tin cans
- Plastic Containers (ketchup, yogurt, ice cream. Javex, shampoo, liquid detergent)

Paper Products

- Newspapers and flyers
- Magazines and Catalogues
- Paper and Envelopes
- Boxboard (e.g. cereal, tissue, detergent boxes & more)
- Paper Bags
- Corrugated Cardboard
- Egg Cartons

How to Recycle

Sort It

- Sort recyclables into two groups: Containers and Paper Products.
- Make sure everything is clean. Rinse and drain beverage.
- Remove lids and caps from your containers, and remove wrap from boxes and paper.

Bag It

- Place paper products and containers into separate clear or transparent blue bags.
- Use only clear blue plastic bags and place recyclables loosely in the bag.

Curb It

- Place your separated clear or transparent blue bags at the curb on recycling day.
- You do not need to cover your recycling.
